

Colorado Cannabis Grower Experience



-) These pictures are taken on the same day in June 2018 by a grower in Colorado.
-) The image on the right shows an untreated plant and its “yellow sticky trap card”, which attracts and captures fungus gnats. Their larvae eat roots and other organic matter, which in turn reduces the ability of the plant to uptake and process nutrients.
-) These cards are tools more than pest control. The grower uses the number of captures to determine a course of action based on the severity of infestation.
-) This demonstrates how use of BAM-FX cannot only improve overall plant quality, but also allow for reduction of inputs in a number of areas including IPM (integrated pest management).
